PROGRAM

Heartland DSC provides youth hunting opportunities to kids less than 16 years of age during the spring (turkey only) and fall hunting seasons.

MISSION

Heartland DSC is the local chapter of Dallas Safari Club (DSC) with members throughout Iowa and Nebraska. Building on the foundation principles of DSC, Heartland DSC focuses these efforts with the primary goal of "GETTING YOUTH OUTDOORS." While there are many very worthy outdoor organizations that encompass youth activities as part of their overall mission, Heartland DSC has identified youth as our primary mission. We realize that if hunting, fishing and other outdoor activities are to remain a viable part of our society, it will be the youth that preserve them into the future. We work towards this goal by educating youth on the benefits of embracing the outdoors by introducing them to all the outdoors has to offer. It will be these next generations that will become voting citizens and determine the future of outdoor activities, wildlife and wild places.

HUNTS

Heartland DSC offers a wide range of hunts including deer, turkey, pheasant and waterfowl. Hunts take place in locations reasonably accessible from the Omaha/Council Bluffs area. All youth will be accompanied by a Heartland DSC representative as well as their parent or guardian on the hunt.

TRACKCHAIR

Heartland DSC has an all-terrain track wheelchair available for use on hunts for those in need to provide mobility in the field. Individuals utilizing the chair will be orientated on its operation prior to the activity.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested youth should apply by completing the application form provided on the back of this document. Applications may be mailed or emailed as outlined on the application form. Parental or guardian signature is required for consideration of an application.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

All applications for spring turkey hunts must be submitted and delivered to Heartland DSC prior to March 1. The application deadline for all fall hunts is August 31.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Heartland DSC board will review all applications and make all final decisions on those individuals that will be awarded a trip. An in-person meeting may be conducted prior to final selection. While our efforts are focused on all youth, we are putting a special emphasis on introducing outdoor activities to those youth that may not otherwise have the opportunity due to disabilities, lack of accessibility, or other life circumstances.
